### Ontario Auto Insurance Five Year Review — Document Released

The Superintendent of Financial Services is responsible for carrying out a review of Part VI of the *Insurance Act* (the Act) dealing with automobile insurance.

Part VI of the Act includes provisions that deal with the approval of forms, motor vehicle liability policies, statutory conditions, direct compensation, limitations on accident insurance, court proceedings, and dispute resolution. Some of the regulations under Part VI include: the Statutory Accident Benefits Schedule (SABS), uninsured automobile coverage, fault determination rules, disputes between insurers, and court proceedings.

The first review has been completed and the Report on the Five Year Review of Automobile Insurance has been delivered to the Minister of Finance.

The report includes feedback received by associations and members (total of 40 submissions) made to FSCO, last summer.

Members should note, that this document has been submitted to the Minister of Finance for review. It is unclear what action the government will be taking on the document. The association is presently analyzing the document and will be working individually and jointly with other health professional associations to provide feedback to the government.

We anticipate meeting with the Minister of Finance in the coming days and we will keep the membership updated on the progress and next steps.
